DECREE

ESTABLISHING THE MISIONERAS GUADALUPANAS DE SANTA ANA


The "Misioneras Guadalupanas de Santa Ana" is hereby established as a public association of the Christian faithful, and as such is recognized as a juridic person in the Diocese of Tyler. As such it is subject to the universal and particular law of the Church as well as its proper statutes approved by the Most Rev. Alvaro Corrada del Rio, S.J., Bishop of Tyler.

The "Misioneras Guadalupanas de Santa Ana" will function as an association of the faithful, centered on the charisms of 1) Apostolic Life: Evangelization, Catechesis, and Education and 2) Contemplative Life: Prayer for vocations and families. The "Misioneras Guadalupanas de Santa Ana" will promote service to the local church through the living of their Rule and Statutes as a radical witness to the Gospel call to holiness of life. It is the desire of those connected with the "Misioneras Guadalupanas de Santa Ana" that by God's ongoing grace this association of the Christian faithful will mature to the point that it will be canonically established as a religious community of women in consecrated life. A group of supporters called pioneers will support them in prayer and in their mission.

The "Misioneras Guadalupanas de Santa Ana" shall be included in official listings of institutions in the Diocese of Tyler.

The Diocese of Tyler gives thanks to God for the good work He has begun in the "Misioneras Guadalupanas de Santa Ana."
